As we watch the news and see hundreds of families all the country in need of emergency supplies, 72-Hour Emergency kits are becoming a priority. To help you begin to address this issue (as each families needs are different), the City of Lowell Health Department and the Upper Merrimack Valley Medical Reserve Corps are purchasing supplies in bulk and assembling **72-Hour Emergency Kits**. Take advantage of discounted pricing obtained through bulk purchasing, and avoid the hassle of running around to gather needed supplies. One-stop shopping! Your \$50 pre-payment will cover a backpack, emergency disaster guide, crank flashlight and radio, tarp, tent, and various first aid and emergency supplies. The complete list of supplies in your backpack is listed on the back of this paper. These supplies will start your preparation of a 72 hour kit.

The following is a list of the items that are in the backpack:

- Red Backpack (all items are placed in this backpack)
- *“It’s a Disaster!and what are YOU gonna do about it??”* (4th Edition, A Disaster Preparedness, Prevention & Basic First Aid Manual, By Bill and Janet Liesbsch)
- AM/FM hand crank radio with LED Flashlight / Strobe/ Siren and Universal 12 volt cell phone Charger
- First Aid Kit
- 10’X 12’ tarp
- Tube tent (2 man)
- Poncho with Hood
- Waterproof box of Matches
- Whistle with Lanyard
- 50’ Nylon Cord
- Survival sleeping bag – Quake Kare – made of durable insulated mylar material that reflects back 90% of body heat. This re-usable thermal blanket is waterproof and windproof
- Instant ice pack
- Leather palm work gloves
- Safety goggles
- Water purification tablets (strip of 10)

This is meant to be a starter kit!
