

I-495 CORRIDOR PUBLIC MEETINGS



The Executive Office of Transportation and Public Works (EOTPW) has been working with the North Middlesex Council of Governments and the Merrimack Valley Planning Commission to examine issues and opportunities for addressing safety and congestion problems along 40 miles of I-495. Assisted by a study advisory group of officials and organizations from the 13 cities and towns along the corridor, EOTPW has developed a plan for near-term improvements (less than 3 years), mid-term improvements (3-8 years), and long-term improvements (more than 8 years).

These meetings will review key findings and go over potential improvement options. The meeting in Lowell will focus on the section of I-495 west of I-93. The meeting in Haverhill with focus on the section of I-495 east of I-93.
