In regards to the above mentioned motion I have been in contact with Police Superintendent Kenneth Lavalley. The Superintendent has informed me that Lieutenant Crowley reported that in the month of April a total of 21 citations were written on Andover Street. Officers assigned to STEP issued 16 of those citations, which 7 of those were for speeding. Lieutenant Crowley also assigned the Speed Board on April 3, 2009 for inbound traffic, and then moved the board to the outbound side on April 14. The board did not record any speed data and the board has since been moved.
